5. Council approved seeking grant funding for the existing Nature Trail for concreting it and working with Greta DeMayo.
6. Council approved the Peavine Basin Sewer Service Connection for Single Family Dwellings Policy, allowing the extension of the sewer line to a single family dwelling when the sewer main is located under the roadway.
7. Council approved the Ballot for the Election of District 1 Officers for 2014-2015.
