1. Council approved Work Session Minutes from March 28, 2016.
2. Council approved Public Hearing Minutes from March 28, 2016.
3. Council approved the Regular Scheduled Meeting Minutes from March 28, 2016.
4. Council voted to approve placing a three way stop at intersections Meadow Lane, Hunter Lane and Gladstone; Meadow Lane, Hunter Lane and Willowwind; and Meadow Lane Willowwind and Gladstone; and a four-way stop at Bluffview and Willowwind and Willowwind and Hunter Lane.
5. Council voted to plan an outing to site in Chatsworth this calendar year to review what they are doing with their solar power to see if it is a viable option and who they worked with. Also to contact GMA to secure some information and the Georgia Solar Association to provide us the appropriate people from a city's prospective for the future installation of solar power.
6. Council voted to approve the Second and Final Reading Ordinance to Amend Chapter 66 of the Code and Ordinances Captioned "Traffic and Vehicles".
7. Council voted to approve the Second and Final Reading Ordinance to Amend Chapter 6 Captioned "Alcoholic Beverages".
8. Council voted to forward the RYAA Facility Use Agreement to RYAA for review and to charge a \$10.00 fee for each child which will be paid to the City of Ringgold.
9. Council voted to approve the Contract to Provide Revenue Management Services Relative to Hotel-Motel Tax.
10. Council approved a 60-day moratorium on the Dumpster Ordinance to allow research.
